

# SUNCOAST Weekly Census 2020 Education Network Update



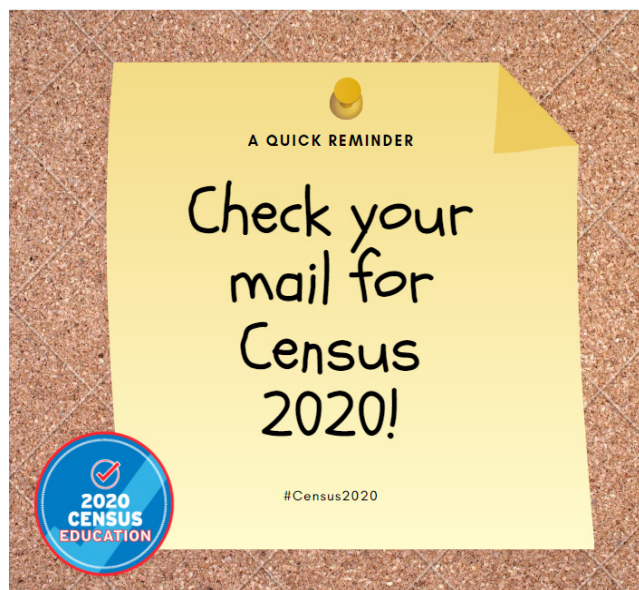

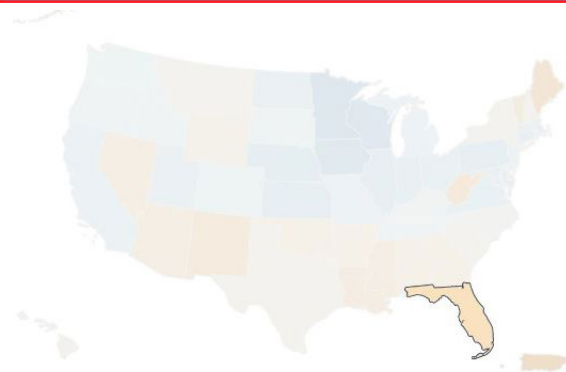
