**FUN FACT: : Children 0–4 were the most undercounted population in the 2010 Census, don't forget to count the kids!**

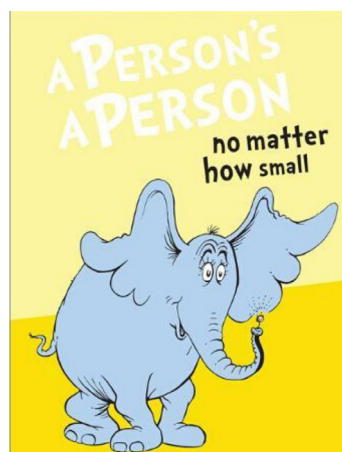

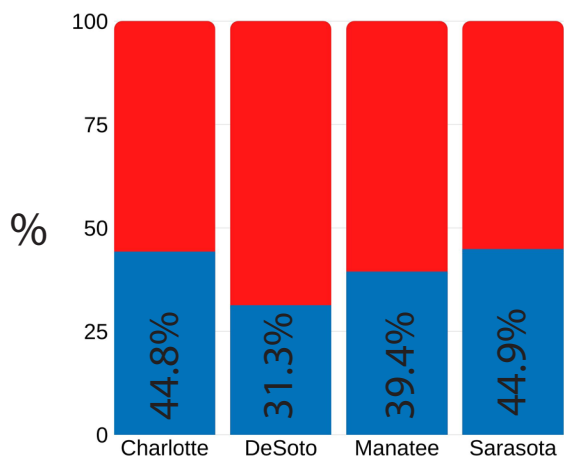
