The **Graduate Certificate in Philanthropic Fundraising** focuses on the latest research on philanthropy, and the practical applications to develop your knowledge base and skills in fundraising.

The **Master of Arts in Philanthropic Studies** allows students to gain experience in understanding and applying cutting edge research and developing critical thinking skills about the complex issues confronting the nonprofit sector.

All of our graduate programs can be completed on campus or online. We also offer some hybrid courses that include online work and an in-residence week in Indianapolis each summer. All of the graduate certificate courses can be applied to our master's degree.
